Good Evening Everyone,

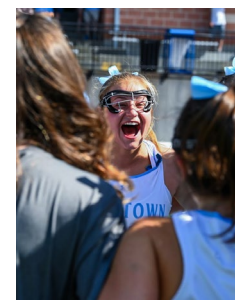
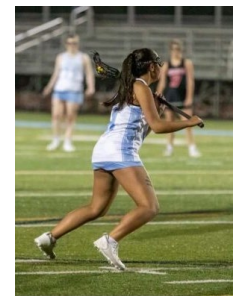
